If anybody wants to have a gallery page on the TSAA website, I'm putting that together. I can get people added when I get material from them. They will be visible to the general public.

Send the following to artbypamelasconley@gmail.com

- 1) Picture for the gallery menu page
Can be either a picture of you, the artist or choose one of your favorite works. I'll be putting a link so when the image is clicked it will go to the page for that artist. If you don't send a photo of yourselves, let me know which of the others to use.
- 2) The artist's page of works
 - a. **Pictures of your work.** I don't know about limits on how much can be stored on the server so I'm thinking to just do no more than 10-15 images for each artist until I can find out more.
 - i. **IMPORTANT:** Don't use high resolution image files. That both keeps storage low but more importantly it keeps people from downloading your art to reuse. I suggest 72dpi and as low a size as you can use that still looks good on the screen but not blown up
 - ii. Please name the files with the title of the work so I can have a caption
 - iii. .jpg is the file type that the website prefers. Please try to send pix in this format. If for some reason you can't, I *can* convert but if I have to make bunches of galleries, that gets time consuming.
 - b. A short **bio** or artist's statement. A paragraph or 2 is plenty. Don't want to detract from the pictures of your actual work.
- 3) Each artist can decide if they want to include contact information. This is totally for you guys

If I get a lot of people send me things all at once, it may take a little bit to get things up. Be patient and don't feel you're being neglected
